

Care and Share Food Bank Hosts Open House & Ribbon Cutting at Newly Expanded Pueblo Facility

Pueblo, CO (Monday, March 28, 2016) – According to Feeding America's Map the Meal Gap, nearly 22,000 people living in Pueblo County are at risk of missing at least one meal every day. The same study reports that there are more than 171,000 people in need of food throughout Care and Share Food Bank's 31-county service area. This startling fact prompted Care and Share to launch Within Reach, a five-year plan to provide access to food for *all* Southern Colorado neighbors at risk of hunger every day.

Understanding that we and our 40 partner agencies in Pueblo County need to reach more neighbors at risk of hunger, we embarked on a campaign to expand our Pueblo facility. The expansion will allow us to engage more volunteers, distribute more food, host more nutrition education classes, and better meet the needs of the community. Thanks to the generosity of the Pueblo community, as well as the support of several key foundations and organizations, we have recently completed this campaign.

We invite the community to the food bank, located at 100 Greenhorn Drive, on Thursday, March 31st for an open house and ribbon cutting from 5:30 p.m. until 6:30 p.m.
