






66,985 POUNDS OF FOOD DISTRIBUTED THROUGH MOBILE MARKET

In the first four months of the coronavirus pandemic, our team distributed 38% more food than during the same time last year. That's astounding! Even before the pandemic, hunger was a daily challenge for 1 in 9 neighbors in Southern Colorado. That number is now closer to 1 in 6.

I want to emphasize how significant your gift is. Your donation helped provide food for children who no longer had access to free and reduced-priced meals at school. It supported seniors who had to stay at home for their health. It created relief for parents who were unexpectedly laid off from their jobs, not knowing when they would get their next paycheck. 
