NEIGHBOR RIGHTS



You have the right to:

- be treated with **dignity and respect**.
- **choose not to answer** any question during online intake. *Please note that some questions are required to qualify for government programs.
- have your data entered anonymously.
- have your **personal data protected** by multiple layers of security and confidentiality.
- request a **paper TEFAP form** instead of being entered in the electronic database.
- self-declare your income without verification (i.e. no proof required).
- access official government documents in your own language.
