


Geographic Breakdown

The dots on this map are where pantries are located. The darker the orange, the more neighbors visited our pantries from that county (this map can also be displayed by zip code instead of county).




Individual Demographics

This report gives you information about the age, gender & race/ethnicity of the neighbors you serve.




Core Household Characteristics

Other Household Characteristics


This report gives you information about your neighbors' households.


Service Trends

This report lets you look at when you serve the most neighbors.




Agency Attributes
